



II OIC Youth Scientific Congress

November 8-11, 2023
Kazan/Tatarstan (Russian Federation)

Brief Information

We would like to invite students, young scientists, researchers and innovators from Russia and the Organization of Islamic Cooperation countries to participate in the II OIC Youth Scientific Congress (hereinafter - the Congress), which will be held on November 8-11, 2023 in Kazan, the capital of the Republic of Tatarstan. The Congress is organized by the Academy of Youth Diplomacy and Kazan (Volga Region) Federal University in partnership with the OIC Standing Committee on Scientific and Technological Cooperation (COMSTECH), the Islamic Cooperation Youth Forum (ICYF) and the Federal Agency for Youth Affairs (Rosmolodezh).

Islamic world countries are developing dynamically, enhancing their scientific potential, which becomes more and more visible in the international arena. Strengthening academic and youth cooperation between Russia and the OIC countries will contribute to further development of human capital of the Islamic world.

The II OIC Youth Scientific Congress will facilitate attracting young people of Russia and the OIC countries to scientific research, promote active cooperation among young people, and contribute to further international research, technical and innovative development. Participation in such scientific events provides young people with opportunities to develop their projects and skills, and promotes effective cooperation between global university communities.

In 2022, the Congress was part of the events devoted to Kazan as the OIC Youth Capital 2022 and attracted more than 1,400 applications from both the OIC countries and regions of the Russian Federation.

Purpose and Objectives

The main **purpose** of the Congress is to strengthen the status of the Republic of Tatarstan as an international platform for dialogue to form prerequisites for sustainable development of international cooperation in science and research with the OIC region.

The Congress has the following **objectives**:

1. To strengthen the unique platform for interaction of young scientists of the OIC countries in the framework of international scientific



cooperation, as determined by the results of the I OIC Youth Scientific Congress.

2. To develop greater awareness and understanding of the Sustainable Development Goals, especially those related to youth and enhancement of global partnerships, such as SDG 4 “Quality Education” and SDG 17 “Partnerships for Sustainable Development”.
3. To publish materials of the OIC Youth Scientific Congress with abstracts of the participants as a joint scientific collection.

Methodology and format

The Congress will be held during four days, November 8-11, 2023, including a cultural program in Kazan. The Congress will open with a plenary session, after which the activity will be organized at 6 venues of Kazan (Volga Region) Federal University in the form of thematic round tables and interactive seminars (sections).

The purpose of the sections is to provide participants with the opportunity to discuss frontier research and modern developments in specific areas such as architecture and design, prosperity and society, international law and education, sustainable development and international relations, petroleum technology, biomedicine and biotechnology, as well as to share their own experience and encourage further scientific, technical and innovative cooperation.

The event will result in the publication of the theses of the finalists of the II OIC Youth Scientific Congress.

The main topic of the Congress: Well-Being and Society in the Context of New Global Challenges.

The Congress will focus on the following **areas**:

1. Current Challenges in Biomedicine and Biotechnology.
2. Wellbeing and Society: Education and International Relations:
 - Modern International Relations: Problems and Prospects for the Development
 - Modern Educational Technologies: Interdisciplinary Research and Practices
 - International Law in Education and Research: Universal and Regional Perspective.
3. Architecture, Design, Art.
4. Petroleum Geology, Oil and Gas Technologies.



Target audience: 100 participants from 56 OIC Member and Observer Countries (students, young scientists, researchers, innovators from the Russian Federation and the OIC countries aged 18-35).

Location: Kazan/Tatarstan (Russian Federation)

Dates: November 8-11, 2023

Official language: English

Participation format: in-person (with written and oral presentation of scientific work)

Expenses: The host party covers accommodation, meals and cultural program in Kazan

Deadline for application: **September 25, 2023, 23:59**

Participants will be awarded a Certificate and a printed copy of the theses collection of the finalists of the II OIC Youth Scientific Congress.
